- Each full-year award is \$2,000. Partial scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded for one semester.

In its 26th year, the Tau Beta Pi Scholarship Program will recognize and award members with funds in support of their senior year of undergraduate study. In 2022, 254 scholarships from 394 applicants were presented.

\$2,000 scholarships are given on the basis of academic achievement, extracurricular activities, and the promise of substantial contributions to the engineering profession. Strong faculty recommendations are an integral component to the application.

Applications are welcome from members or candidates for membership who will be initiated by June 1. Recipients must be full-time senior undergraduate engineering students during the 2023-24 academic year. Full-time students graduating in the fall semester are eligible for partial scholarships.

Scholarships will be announced in early July. Scholars will receive \$2,000 payable in two equal payments in mid-September and mid-January. Partial scholarships of \$1,000 will be sent in mid-September.
