# President's Letter

Dear Reader,

To Whomever at the National level reads this:

This has been an interesting year in Tau Beta Pi CA-Alpha. This year, the new generation of officers took over and tried out a variety of new things that they'd been wanting to try for a while. The wave of change began in the fall semester, and carried on over into the spring semester. At this stage, it is difficult to tell whether it will continue into this next year or not, but I suspect that it will.

In Fall 2017, the Vice Presidents (who are in charge of the candidate semester/initiation process in our chapter) made substantial changes to our candidate requirements, with the goal of reducing the workload while maintaining the integrity of the process. Officer Development projects, in which candidates work with officers on some kind of officer-level project, were made mandatory. Service and professional development event attendance requirements were reduced in number. As a result of these changes, the chapter (logically) held less service and professional development events, and officer-candidate interactions were mildly increased. Other aspects of the candidate semester were changed as well, in an attempt to better include prospective members with a wide range of interests.

While this was going on, the Fall 2017 president began formulating a new elections procedure, which would be a mixture of by-application and in-person elections. For executive officers and committee chairs, elections would happen the "old way" (in-person), while committee officer positions would be filled by voting on them based on their application. The president also signed our chapter up for Big Give, a campus-wide fundraising drive that takes place in Spring.

In Spring 2018, the Vice Presidents continued the trend of decreasing the number of requirements. The president (myself) implemented a new elections procedure, reworking how in-person elections are held, and creating an optional application for election for those officers who were unable to attend in-person elections. The idea was based on the Fall 2017 idea, but not precisely the same. I also implemented Big Give, which we had signed up for the semester before.

New in Spring 2018 were the new services that came out of our Projects committee. Under this semester's chair, a LinkedIn guide and critiquing system was created, design of and accumulation of data for a course guide was done, and a revamp of the Bent Buddies officer-candidate pairing system was implemented. Additionally, our Professional Development committee branched out and began inviting out alumnus/a industry contacts to run our professional development events, which increased the attractiveness of these events to the general campus community. Our Publicity committee experimented with Facebook advertising for our events, to great success.

(Note: the president had known this in advance, and had checked with the rental company about this, and had been told incorrectly that it would be fine to rent by debit card.) Luckily, the two renters had traveled to the rental place together, and the other was able to miraculously borrow a car from their grandparents. This all happened while the president was already en route/driving, so coordination was difficult; but people really came in clutch.

- On Saturday, one of the cars going to Boreal Mtn got rear-ended at a stop sign (snowy roads). The car (which happened to be the rental) was damaged but drivable. Luckily the addit'l insurance had been purchased, and when the car was returned, no addit'l fees were incurred.
- There were some difficulties organising rides back from Boreal Mtn, because somebody from the cabin had to go pick up a car load, and the skiiers didn't all want to leave at the same time. Next time, think this through more in advance.

**Description**

Cal Day is a yearly event hosted by the university to give prospective freshman a look at life at cal. As an organization we were able to sign up for tabling both in the college of engineering and on Sproul.

**Purpose**

We wanted to get our name out there so that freshman know about mainly the academic services we offer both engineers and non engineers alike. Current publicity goals have been to make TBP known for more than just the test bank. We also sold Berkeley Engineering shirts, again to make it known that we are the engineering honor society, not just a test bank.

**Organization**

As pubs chair, I organized most of the event, which was mainly emailing ESC and the Sproul organizers to set up a spot for tabling and then having people sign up for time slots on the schedule. I wanted at least one officer and another person at each table. I found that having more than that was very crowded and unnecessary. Set up and clean up were just bringing and then returning the banner and shirts to the TBP office.



### **Cost**

The cost of the Berkeley Engineering shirts were \$329. We sold them at \$12 a shirt. We did not only sell them at Cal Day however.

### **Problems**

The main problem was with the ESC not allowing us to sell shirts in front of the college of engineering, where all the prospective engineers and their families would be. As a result we had to sign up to also table on Sproul, where we had significantly less interest since most of our services are for engineers, not general students. Also on Sproul they had us share a tiny table with another student group, so even if you were interested in engineering it was hard to notice us in the first place. Other problems arose from the shirt price being \$12, I would say that in the future it would be worth while to make cheaper shirts to sell them at \$10 so people can just hand you a \$10 bill instead of scrambling for change.

### **Results**

Overall we sold all of the old leftover cal engineering shirts (around 12) and probably 6 Berkeley engineering shirts, totaling in a couple hundred dollars of revenue. We were also able to chat with some prospective engineers about life at Cal, but I am almost 100% certain our efforts would've been better spent at the engineering buildings had the ESC allowed us to fundraise there. I think it would be a worth while issue to bring to the attention of the ESC next year. Their reasoning was that Cal day should not be a place where we try to profit off the prospective students, however it hardly seems fair that the university can make thousands off of sales at the student store, which is open on Cal Day, and we aren't even allowed to make a tiny profit for our organization which is mainly funded not through the UC.
